8-10-17, **Tulsa, OK** : "WE THE PEOPLE OKLAHOMA" continues to work on behalf of the people to keep our elected officials accountable to those they vowed to serve. In an announcement this morning Rogers County Sheriff Scott Walton has hired Betty Shelby as a reserve officer for the Sheriff department. After being acquitted of the murder of Terrence Crutcher she was unhappy with her reassignment and stated she was tired of being a paper pusher in a tiny cubicle with no windows. Her concern was for her own comfort as opposed to what is best for the community. It is our opinion that Betty Shelby is unfit to be a police officer, which was also the recommendation of the jury that acquitted her on manslaughter charges. From evidence that has been shown to the public Betty Shelby is easily rattled and in the video of her interview several days after the shooting she was seen sobbing, screaming, and collapsing on the floor. After her trial the jury chose to write a letter to the court and in part stated "Many on the Jury could never get comfortable with the concept of Betty Shelby being blameless for Mr. Crutcher's death..." adding, "We question her judgment as a law enforcement officer." They also asked that her decision making skills be reviewed by the Tulsa Police Department.

Betty Shelby's lack of accountability and empathy is astounding. As is the fact that Rogers County Sheriff Walton believes she is fit for duty as a reserve officer.

"WE THE PEOPLE OKLAHOMA" will continue to push for transparency and accountability from our public officials. We will continue to work on behalf of the citizens of the great state of Oklahoma because when concerned citizens make their voices heard positive changes are made.
